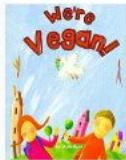


VEGAN CHILDREN'S BOOKS

When we try to raise our children with maximum compassion, it's natural to find being surrounded by the message that animal exploitation is 'normal' difficult, and that's just us adults!

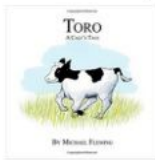

The story of Toro the calf and his escape from a factory farm, Fleming's book explains the cruelty of the dairy industry in a way that's suitable for children.

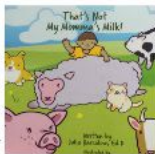
That's Not My Momma's Milk
